AAA has been rigorously developed in consultation with experts across a range of sectors that include: urban planning, corporate services, open space management and crime prevention.

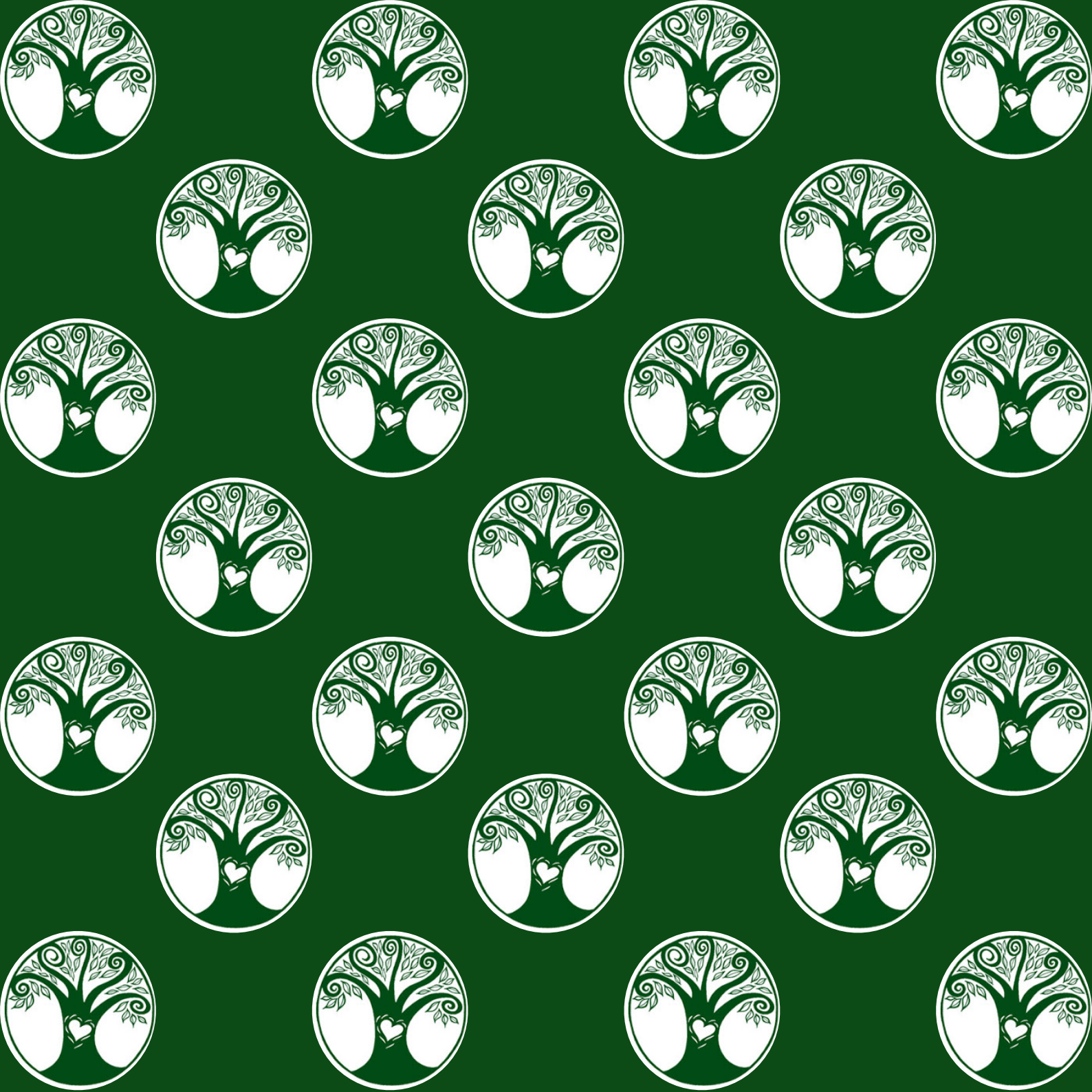
Greenwood Institute has tailored **AAA** from a business development perspective providing for a *whole of business* approach.

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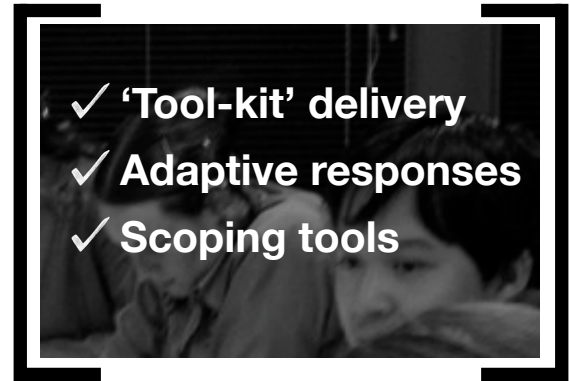
