Two modules constitute a full day of training delivery focused on participant needs and learning.

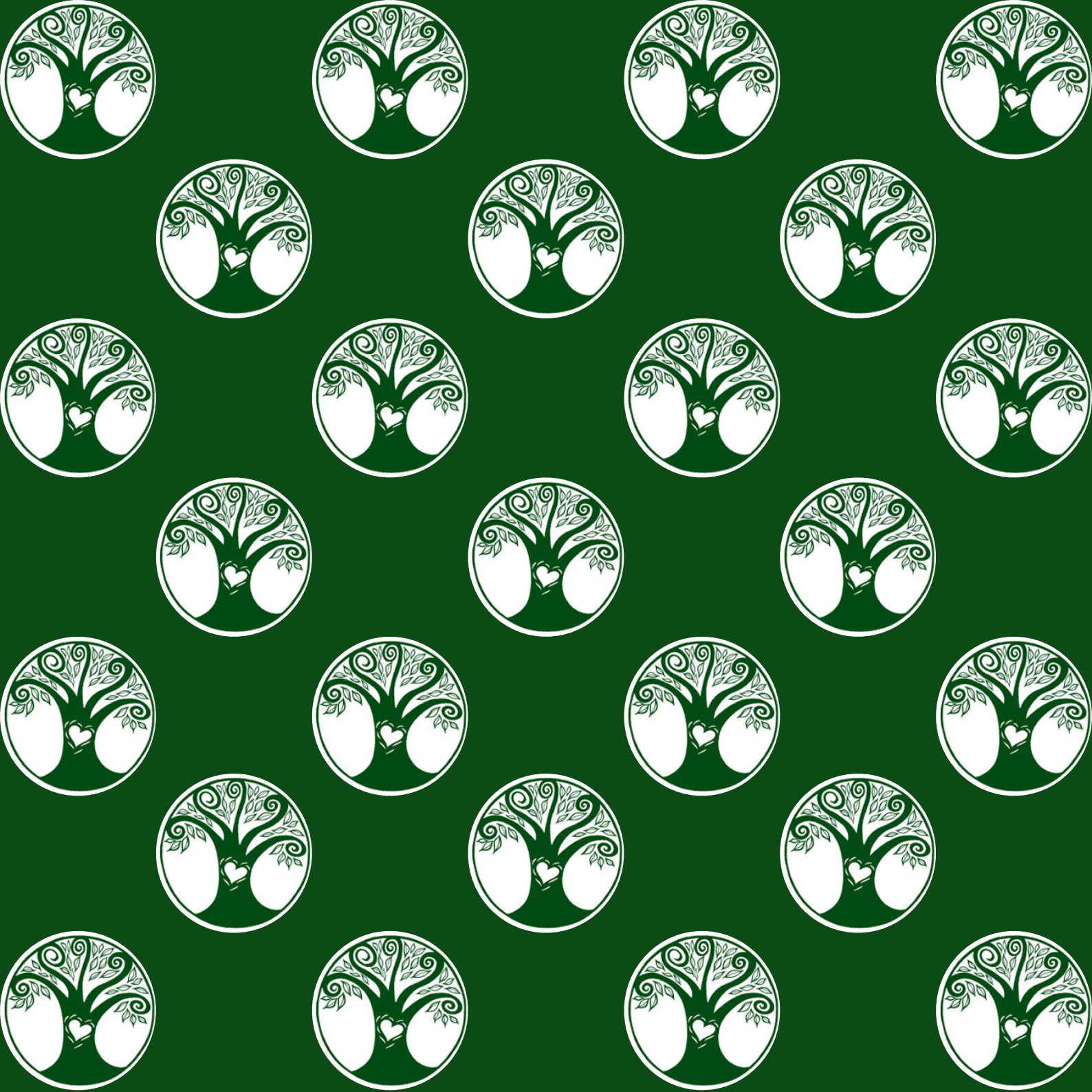
This tailoring allows for a more bespoke delivery to individual communities.
